



The Life of Saasaan Aal Kanaan is in Danger



Save his Life

According to the latest news released by the headquarters of Komala; last month Saasaan Aal Kanaan born in 1967 in the city of Sanandaj, Iran has been arrested and imprisoned along with tens of other people in Sanandaj. In a ruling passed by the courts of the Islamic Republic of Iran, Saasaan has been sentenced to death and awaits his death. According to the ruling of Judge Reza Fatemi, Saasaan is convicted for the crime of participating and being involved with Komala and hence he is convicted of opposing and standing against God. It is important to mention that other prisoners arrested at the same time in Sanandaj, have all been sentenced to long term prison terms. To name a couple, Haady Adnaan Ghadery and Osmaan Morady have each been sentenced to ten years of imprisonment.

In our previous newsletter, we have informed the public of the new wave of political executions taking place in Kurdistan by the hands of the Islamic regime of Iran. We have informed the public of the hidden terrors of political opposition members; arrests; persecutions and physical and mental tortures committed by the Islamic Republic of Iran against innocent people. We have informed the public of the regime's new plan for suppressing the Kurds and creating fear and terror among the people of this nation. The death sentence of Saasaan Aal Kanaan is yet another step towards fulfilling this plan. Saasaan's execution is nothing but a way for the regime to threaten the people of Kurdistan and hence suppress the movements of freedom fighters. If the freedom fighters and the youth of Kurdistan are to be executed for their dissatisfaction with the Islamic Republic Iran and if they are to be imprisoned for the crime of opposing this regime; then the names of not thousands but millions of such people should be written on the regime's execution list.

We hereby ask all humanitarians to object to Saasaan's execution sentence and inform the United Nations and all humanitarian organizations of this inhuman criminal act and help prevent another innocent life from being taken. Encourage all political organizations and international media to force the Islamic Republic of Iran to abrogate capital punishment in Iran so that the lives of people like Saasaan and other freedom fighters can no longer be threatened. Do not allow

Iran's plan of suppressing the Kurdish people to continue with our silence. Do not allow the blood of these innocent people to be sacrificed for the benefit of a religious dictatorship that has no purpose but to create fear and agony among people. Do whatever it takes but save the lives of Saasaan Aal Kanaan and others in his situation.
